Guidelines

Deposit, Payment, Taxes, Guarantees and Set-Up Fee

To confirm a date, a signed contract, sponsor agreement (for non-members) and a non-refundable deposit of \$500.00 is required for your event.

Your function should be completely designed, including menus and all details, two weeks prior to your actual date. The final guest count for your event will be required 7 days prior. (This is considered a minimum guarantee for which you will be charged and is not subject to reduction, unless approved by the catering manager). A 6% sales tax will be added to food sales. A 20% gratuity is added to the price of all food and beverage. There is also a \$500.00 Room Rental. Payment of the remaining balance is due 10 days after receiving the final bill.

St. Davids Golf Club Policy

St. Davids requires certain standards of their members and guests. Please make sure your guests are aware of the following:

- Jeans or Denim are not permitted in the clubhouse at anytime.
- Cell phone use is not permitted in the clubhouse.
- Parking in the front circle is not permitted under any circumstances.
- St. Davids Golf Club is a smoke free facility.

DIRECTIONS TO ST. DAVIDS GOLF CLUB

From turnpike at Valley Forge Exit – Exit at route 202 South to Swedesford Road exit. Make left onto Swedesford Road. Make a left on Old Eagle School then a left on Upper Gulph Road. Follow approximately a ¼ mile to Radnor Road and make a right. Follow for about a ¼ mile and the Club entrance is on the left just before the Valley Forge Military Academy Chapel.

From Schuylkill Expressway (Route 76) – Take Blue Route (476) South then follow directions for Blue Route going South.

From Blue Route (Route 476) going South – Take the St. Davids/Villanova exit (13) make a right onto Route 30 and an immediate left onto King of Prussia Road. Follow King of Prussia Road to the third light (Eagle Road). Make a left and follow Eagle Road up to the next light (Radnor Street Road) and make a right. Follow for about an 1/8 mile and the Club entrance is on the right just past the Valley Forge Military Academy Chapel.

From Blue Route (Route 476) going North – Take the St. Davids/Villanova exit (13) and cross over Route 30 onto King of Prussia Road. Follow King of Prussia Road to the third light (Eagle Road). Make a left and follow Eagle Road up to the next light (Radnor Street Road) and make a right. Follow for about an 1/8 mile and the Club entrance is on the right just past the Valley Forge Military Academy Chapel.

From Lancaster Avenue (route 30) – Traveling east, turn left in Strafford at Eagle Road (Spread Eagle Village, Mobile Station). Follow through one flashing light to second traffic light (Radnor Street Road). Turn left (you will see sign for Valley Forge Military Academy). Club is approximately 1/8 mile on right side.

From Lancaster Avenue (route 30) – Traveling west, turn right at King of Prussia Road (just past Blue Route overpass). Go to third traffic light, about one mile, turn left on Eagle Road. Go about ¾ mile to first traffic light. Turn right past Valley Forge Military Academy to club entrance ¼ mile on right.

To Every Member:

The membership is advised that the following policy statement was approved by the Board of Directors at the regular monthly meeting on July 31, 1986.

It is the policy of St. Davids Golf Club that all employees participating in the sale or service of alcoholic beverages be specifically directed to:

- 1) study and become familiar with all available material designed to enable them to detect evidences of intoxication of members or guests and to avoid serving intoxicated persons;
- 1) never serve alcohol to minors;
- 1) refuse to serve alcoholic beverages to any person who appears to be intoxicated or on the verge of becoming intoxicated;
- 1) refrain from providing assistance in leaving the premises to any intoxicated person intending to operate a motor vehicle;
- 1) off to call a taxi or find a driver for any intoxicated person intending to leave the premises;
- 1) advise any visibly intoxicated person who appears to be intending to drive a motor vehicle away from the Club property that the police will be called and to call the police if the person refuses the offer of a taxi or other assistance;
- 1) report to management any incident involving intoxication on Club property with a detailed report of the facts that will be reviewed by the House Committee.

It is important that each member fully appreciate the tremendous responsibility that is placed on the staff and management of our Club. We ask each member's cooperation and support as the Pennsylvania State Law is quite exact in the placing of liability for serving intoxicated or appearing to be intoxicated members or guests.

A non-refundable deposit is required within seven days of Board acceptance to secure the date. The deposit will be 25% of the expected gross income with a maximum of \$1,000.

The sponsor is responsible for the deposit once the request is approved by the Board of Directors.
